**The Local Area Coordination Network** exists to create a supportive network and resources for the long-term development and success of Local Area Coordination and associated reforms in England and Wales.

We work with Local Authorities and other statutory services alongside local communities and provider organisations to re-imagine the possibilities of how services can become more personal, flexible, accountable and efficient.

As the Network enters its second full year of operation we are looking for up to 3 non-executive directors to join the small group of people who founded or supported the early development.

Our current Chair will also be stepping down so we are also recruiting a new Chair for the Board.

We are looking for people who share our vision and passionate commitment to working with local people realizing their own vision of a good life whilst contributing to strong, connected communities.

Applicants will need to be able to demonstrate that they understand and can fulfil the obligations of a Director (or Chair if they are interested in that role too) as set out in the role description and can give the time needed to carry out that role well.

We are especially looking for people who have a contribution to make in two or more of the following areas:

- Lived experience of working with a Local Area Coordinator as a local partner or community member
- Experience in marketing or communications
- Have networks which can be used to extend our influence and understanding
